This qualification is a mandatory entry requirement for the Construction Industry. This qualification provides an introduction to Work Place Health & Safety which is the Employers responsibility to provide for all Employees in accordance with the Victorian OH&S Act 2004.

Pathways to Further Studies

On successful completion of this course, participants are therefore eligible for issuance of a Construction Industry OH&S Induction card (CI card issued by Work Safe Victoria) and may be eligible for partial credit transfer for entry into related courses or units of competence. All participants will be advised to discuss this option with future training providers if they undertake further training in a 'like' area)

Entry Requirements

There are no prerequisite units for this qualification.

A range of skills are recommended in reading and speaking that would enable an individual to:

- Read and interpret signs, instructions and procedures, and
- Communicate clearly with a range of individuals and as part of a team

It is compulsory for all candidates to present a photo ID issues on behalf of a government department at the time of enrollment. These can include:

Driving License, Learner Permit, Passport, Key Pass, Shooters License, Forklift

Course Cost and Duration

This program is delivered over a period of 6 hours.

Your knowledge and skills will be assessed using a combination of methods such as problem solving, role plays and observations of practical demonstrations in a class-room setting as appropriate to the element of competency and (ii) assignments/written questions incorporated in a workbook, and (iii) a multi-choice test
