

Job Services Australia

Job Services Australia is a new employment services initiative being implemented by the Australian Government from 1st July 2009.

The new JSA will provide jobseekers with more personalized help, better targeted services and greater access to training opportunities and work experience in areas of skills shortage through the Government's \$2 billion Productivity Places Program.

As of 6th May 2009, all registered Job seekers will receive a letter and information sheet explaining changes to the existing employment services. All Job seekers should continue their usual contact with Centrelink and CVGT until such time as new arrangements are made.

Some job seekers may be referred to a new provider as a result of Job Services Australia.

Job seekers who wish to voluntarily change providers should contact Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations on 1800 805 260 before 1st July 2009.
