



Bendigo Bank goes SBAT! Application

Bendigo Bank is offering Australian School Based Apprenticeships in Financial Services to young people in the Goldfields region.

The banking sector is one of many financial sectors that are experiencing difficulty attracting not only quality employees, but specifically youth into their workforce.

To address SWL, skills and labour shortage needs the South East LLEN formed a partnership with the Bendigo Bank and developed a School Based Apprenticeship and Traineeship (SBAT) program called "Bendigo Bank Goes SBAT!" to begin providing school based entry into the finance and banking industry.

CVGT through the Workplace Learning Coordinators Program is pleased to be able to support this initiative in promoting the program to all schools across the Goldfields LLEN region.

This unique and innovative program not only aims to provide students in year 11 and 12 in 2011 with hands on experience in the banking and finance industry; but also to provide them with a Certificate III in Financial Services and the possibility of ongoing employment with Bendigo Bank.

To apply interested young people will need to complete the online application (below)

Applications will close on **Thursday 25 November 2010** after which all applicants will be contacted, with short listed applicants invited to a briefing session on **Tuesday 30 November 2010** which will include a Literacy and Numeracy test. Students will then be contacted individually and invited to an interview. After this process is completed each student will be notified of the outcome.

Successful applicants will work one day per week at one of the participating Bendigo Bank branch offices - Eaglehawk, Pall Mall, Mitchell St, Bendigo Central or Strath Hill, and **undertake the Certificate III in Financial Services, delivered in the workplace by Chisholm Institute.**
