



FOOD HANDLERS CERTIFICATE & RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

For many industries these qualifications are mandatory entry requirements. These qualifications allow a person to work in service industries, such as kitchen hands, cooks, chefs, catering staff, food and beverage attendants, housekeeping and, laundry staff, sandwich hands, cafe and fast food outlet cooking crew and sales people and owner-operators of small businesses such as catering operations or retail food outlets.

PATHWAYS TO FURTHER STUDIES

By successfully completing a Food Handlers Certificate the participant is eligible to continue their studies and enroll in Certificate III in Hospitality (Operations), Certificate III in Hospitality (commercial Cookery).

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no prerequisite units for this qualification. Preferred pathways for candidates considering this qualification include some vocational experience in the hospitality industry or a strong desire to work within the hospitality sector.

DELIVERY METHOD

The delivery of this program will be conducted within a group classroom setting. Training manuals and workbooks are supplied which include all materials used in the training sessions and all reference and assessment materials.

ASSESSMENT METHOD

Assessment will be undertaken in accordance with the relevant applicable legislation. Participants will be provided with comprehensive learner guides. Your knowledge and skills will be assessed using a combination of methods such as problem solving, role plays and observations of practical demonstrations in a classroom setting as appropriate to the element of competency and (ii) assignments/written questions incorporated in a workbook, and (iii) a multi-choice test.

Upon successful completion of this course you will obtain nationally recognised statements of attainment for:

- SITXOHS002A - 'Follow Workplace Hygiene'
- Responsible Service of Alcohol certificate issued by Liquor Licensing Victoria.

QUALIFICATIONS
