Do you want a skilled,
keen and motivated worker?



Employers may receive up to \$10,000 in Australian
Government assistance if they hire an eligible job seeker
aged 50 or older under the Restart programme*.



WHAT IS RESTART?

The Restart programme is a wage subsidy paid to employers which aims to assist mature age job seekers participate in the workplace by encouraging employers to take on workers 50 years of age or older. The full rate of the Restart subsidy is paid in four six-monthly instalments.

JOBSEEKER ELIGIBILITY

- Must be aged 50 or older
- No previous employment relationship with the employer
- No workers compensation claims with the employer.

PLACEMENT ELIGIBILITY

- Must be sustainable and ongoing after the Restart subsidy has ceased
- Must be a minimum of 15 hours of work per week
- Must not attract any other government wage subsidies
- Must not be commission based or subcontracting arrangement
- Can be an apprenticeship or traineeship.

EMPLOYER ELIGIBILITY

- Employer must not to be an immediate family member of the jobseeker
- Must be a legal employer with an ABN
- Must have received no previous wage subsidies for the jobseeker
- Must not be a Commonwealth or State Government department.
