

JOB COMMITMENT BONUS

Encouraging long-term unemployed young Australians find and keep a job!

Under the Job Commitment Bonus, job seekers aged 18 to 30 will receive up to \$6,500 (tax free) in Australian Government assistance if they enter and maintain employment for two years*



JOB COMMITMENT BONUS



The Job Commitment Bonus is paid in two 12 monthly payments:

- \$2,500 after 12 months employment
- \$4,000 after 24 months employment.

JOB SEEKER ELIGIBILITY

- Young Australians aged 18 to 30
- Must have been on income support (Newstart or Youth Allowance, as a job seeker) for at least 12 months
- Must maintain continuous employment for both the 12 and the 24 month period
- Must declare income that is sufficient to remove income support completely for the entire 12 and 24 month periods.

PLACEMENT ELIGIBILITY

- Employment may be with a single employer but may also be multiple placements
- The Department of Human Services will pay the Job Commitment Bonus directly to the job seeker at the end of the 12 and 24 month qualifying periods, upon suitable confirmation that their work has been ongoing and they have not returned to income support.

JOB SEEKER RESPONSIBILITY

- Claims for the Job Commitment Bonus must be made within 90 days after the end of the 12 and 24 month qualifying periods.
- You will need to provide copies of **all** your payslips as evidence of continuous employment to claim the bonus.
