What is a Wage Subsidy?

A wage subsidy is a financial incentive of **up to \$10,000*** to encourage businesses to hire and train eligible job seekers.

Is my business eligible? Your business is eligible for a wage subsidy if you:



Have an ABN



Haven't already received a wage subsidy for the same job seeker



Are not an Australian, state or territory government agency

What kind of jobs can I offer?

- ✓ Ongoing full-time jobs
- ✓ Ongoing part-time jobs
- ✓ Jobs that comply with Australian employment standards
- ✓ Apprenticeships or traineeships

- ✗ Short-term or seasonal work that will not lead to ongoing employment
- ✗ For a family member
- ✗ A job that displaces a current employee
- ✗ Commission based

Who can I hire?

To receive a wage subsidy, the job seeker you employ must be registered with CVGT Australia. Other eligibility requirements are based on a job seeker's circumstances.

Wage Subsidy Summary

Restart

Up to \$10,000 for employing eligible job seekers aged 50 or older.

DSS Wage Subsidy

Up to \$1,650 for employing job seekers with disability, illness or injury.

Long Term Unemployed

Up to \$6,000 for employing job seekers registered with CVGT for 12 months or more.

Wage Support

As negotiated between CVGT and the employer.
