CVGT WORK ASSIST

CVGT can help injured employees keep their job!

Work Assist is a free service available to employers to help an employee who may be at risk of losing their job because of an injury, disability or medical condition (including depression, anxiety and stress).

The Work Assist program helps an employer to create a flexible, individualised program to help them keep their employee and may include:

- Advice on redesigning a job so an employee can keep working
- Workplace assessment to determine if any changes are needed
- Making changes to the workplace to support an employee
- Specialised equipment to help an employee do their job.

To be eligible for Work Assist, an employee must:

- provide recent (within two years) evidence of the injury, disability or medical condition
- have been employed, or is expected to be employed for more than eight hours per week for at least 13 weeks
- be aged between 16 – 64 years
- be an Australian resident
- not be currently receiving DES service
- be assessed by a DES provider as requiring assistance to maintain employment.

Employers and employees can register directly with CVGT Australia.
