Transition to Work is a service to support young people aged 15-21 on their journey to employment.

The service has a **strong focus on practical support** and **work experience** to **build your skills, confidence and readiness for work.**

The 'Transition to Work' program is much more than just getting a job, if you've left school early, or had trouble getting a job then CVGTs Transition to Work program is for you!

Our Transition to Work team have a strong focus on helping you build the skills and confidence to enter the work force including apprenticeships and traineeships. Our Transition to Work team are also well connected to assist you on the right pathway to reach your education goals.

How we help

You have come to us because you have:-

- made a choice to register directly with us
- been referred to us by Centrelink
- been referred to us by a jobactive provider.

From your first appointment, we will take the time to get to know you, your interests and your goals.

We know that sometimes there's things making it hard for you to work or study. We will support and encourage you as we help you develop a plan that identifies your work and/or education goals, and how you are going to achieve them.

We will contact local employers and education providers to identify opportunities to find the right option for you.

With CVGT as your job partner, our involvement doesn't end once you start work. We will stay in touch to make sure you're settling in and to answer any questions you may have – this is called post placement support. Generally tailored support is offered for the first six months of employment.

Who it's for

We work with early school leavers or young people who are having trouble getting a job after leaving school. To be part of our program, you need to be:

- aged 15-21
- an Australian citizen or hold a permanent visa, a New Zealand Special Category Visa or a nominated visa (including Temporary Protection Visa or Safe Haven Visa).

Eligibility will also depend on your circumstances; contact your local CVGT Transition to Work to find out more.
